Prepare for this event by reviewing our **Gear Condition Checklist** and take note of any gear that might need repairs! Bring your busted gear.

We will have repair essentials available for sale, we have the knowledge, and we are prepared to walk you through the process of repairing it yourself. Learning to repair seams, tears, straps and buckles on tents, packs, footwear, and apparel can add years to the life of your gear.

Gear Condition Checklist ← second level heading

Sleeping Bags & Pads ← third level heading

Don't risk *losing insulation* or *suffering from a deflated sleeping pad*. Closely review the entire bag for rips and busted seams. Fill your sleeping pad with air and gently apply pressure to the pad. Listen closely for the sound of air escaping from a faulty valve or puncture.

- Seams
- Zippers
- Draw cords
- Retainers
- Velcro
- Valves

Tents & Hammocks ← third level heading

No one wants a *leaky tent* or *risk falling from their hammock*. Ensure to review the following items to ensure a comfortable trip. Set up your tent or hammock and closely inspect them.

- Taped seams
- Zippers

- Velcro
- Poles
- Guylines
- Tensioners
- Loops
- Straps
- Carabiners
- Stakes
- Mesh
